

1. Minutes of Meeting held at St Michaels Hall, 7.30pm on 11th May 1987. Attendance 96.

Introduction - Cllr Mrs Carlton outlined the current position with regard to the development of land at the east of Norwich Road and the possible development of further land to the north east end of Broyle Road. The likelihood of a Tree Preservation Order (TPO) on the land was also reported.

Concern was expressed regarding highway access and the vehicular impact on the East Broyle area.

Formation of Association. By an overwhelming majority, those present decided to establish an East Broyle Residents Association.

All were elected without dissent, apart from Mrs Helen Carlton. Her political/District Council involvement was questioned from the floor. Mrs Carlton suitably replied and on a vote being taken, the meeting expressed a clear wish for Cllr Mrs Carlton to serve on the Committee.

Thanks were expressed by the Chairman to Cllr Mrs Carlton for all her efforts in launching the Association.

Summersdale Residents Association - Mr Reg Plum, who has been an active member of the Summersdale Residents Association, was invited to address the meeting. Mr Plum spoke of the advantages of such an Association and the need to establish a sound financial base. The need to keep the Association non-political was endorsed by Mr Plum.

Business from the floor of the meeting

An annual household subscription fee of £1.50 per house was proposed and seconded. An amendment of £2.00 per house was carried by a large majority.

3. Any Other Business

Questions from the floor concerned:

a. The possible Roundabout at the junction of Norwich Road and St Pauls Road.

b. The possible highway development of the railway line to the north of Worcester Road.

It would appear that neither are likely in the immediate future.

c. The desirability of a Crime Prevention liaison with the Neighbourhood Watch scheme.
